Last year the Otto Bruyns Public Library of Northfield smashed all the records for our summer reading programs. In the **Summer of 2014** the students crushed the adults in the number of books read! Last year, **137 adults read 519 books, while 187 students read 1,446 books!** This summer maybe

The adult reading program is a little different. Adults must sign up starting June 18th to participate. After each book read they are given a chance ticket for a drawing held in late August. Prizes will be provided by local businesses. The more books read, the more chances to win a nice prize.

the adults will be able to keep up. Summer Reading signups start Thursday, June 18th. Come in to register. The first 200 students to sign up will receive a free tote and the first 100 adults will receive a free tote.

After every six chapter books (Or 10 Easy Readers) young

readers get coupons to Rita's Water Ice and other local businesses for free treats. They will be given a reading card to write the title and author of books read with a brief description of the story.

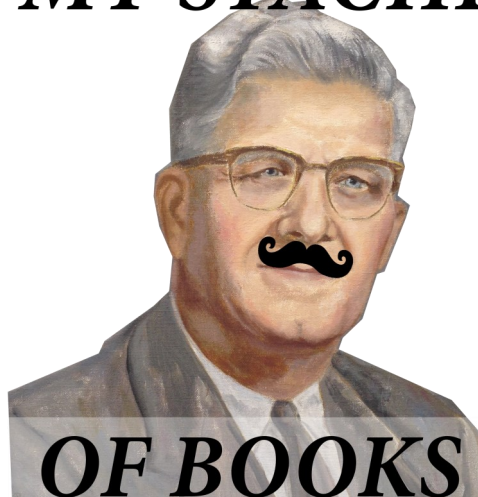
For our early readers there is a grab jar where they can pick small toys to reward themselves after completing 10 picture books. At the end of August the independent, student reader with the most books will be honored.
